WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- ◆ Davidson county residents who qualify for unemployment or have experienced a reduction in household income, had extra household expenses, or experienced a financial hardship due to COVID-19
- ◆ You are facing potential housing instability or homelessness
- ◆ You have a household income at or below 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI)
